



**Announcement**  
**on the application to seek permission to enter the Kingdom of Thailand by non-Thai**  
**nationals with valid work permits or those who have been granted permission from**  
**Thai Government agencies to work in the Kingdom of Thailand**

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The Royal Thai Government's invocation of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No.1) dated 25 March B.E. 2563 (2020) to control the outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), closes the entry into the Kingdom of non-Thai nationals, in accordance with the laws on communicable diseases and immigration. However, clause 3 (5) of the Regulation issued under the said Emergency Decree, also allows non-Thai nationals **who either possess a valid work permit or have already been granted permission from a Thai Government agency to work in the Kingdom**, to apply for permission to enter the Kingdom.

It is, however, requested that only those in urgent need to enter the Kingdom may submit an application for entry. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, in consultation with the Board of Investment and the Ministry of Labour, will consider all requests for entry on a case by case basis, taking into account urgency and economic importance, among others.


The procedure for non-Thai nationals who wish to submit an application for entry is as follows:

1. Contact the Royal Thai Embassy in Canberra or the Royal Thai Consulate-General in Sydney to apply for "Certificate of Entry into the Kingdom of Thailand" at least 10 working days before the date of intended departure. The applicant must present: (1) a copy of his work permit or a copy of letter of permission issued by a Thai Government agency (in most cases, by the Ministry of Labour) to work in Thailand; (2) a valid health insurance policy covering all expenditures of medical treatment, including COVID-19 worth at least 100,000 USD.

2. The Royal Thai Embassy or the Royal Thai Consulate-General will forward the application to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Bangkok. If the application is approved, the Royal Thai Embassy or the Royal Thai Consulate-General will be instructed to issue the "Certificate of Entry into the Kingdom of Thailand" and appropriate visa to the applicant.

At the port of departure/embarkation (e.g. airline check-in counter), the approved applicant is required to present (1) a “Certificate of Entry into the Kingdom of Thailand” issued by the Royal Thai Embassy or the Royal Thai Consulate-General; (2) a completed and signed “Declaration Form” obtained from the Royal Thai Embassy or the Royal Thai Consulate-General; (3) a ‘Fit to Fly Health Certificate’ issued no more than 72 hours before departure.; and (4) a health insurance covering all expenditures of medical treatment, including COVID-19, while traveling to Thailand in the amount of at least 100,000 USD.

Upon entry into the Kingdom, non-Thai nationals will be subjected to a 14-day State Quarantine at a Government- designated Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) facility at their own expenses, and obliged to comply with the Government’s disease prevention measures pursuant to clause 11 of the Regulation issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree.

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<p>I declare and accept that I shall comply with the disease prevention measures prescribed by the Government of Thailand under Clause 11 of the <i>Regulation issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 1)</i>, which may include, but are not limited to, the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>(a) cleaning by wiping surfaces of relevant places before organisation of activities and disposal of waste on a daily basis;</li><li>(b) wearing surgical masks or cloth masks;</li><li>(c) washing hands with soap, alcohol, gel, or disinfectant;</li><li>(d) keeping a distance of at least 1 metre apart while sitting or standing to prevent physical contact or the spread of disease through saliva droplets;</li><li>(e) limiting the number of participants in activities to prevent overcrowding or reducing the time spent on activities as necessary on the basis of avoidance of physical contact; and</li><li>(f) complying with additional measures introduced, which may include the utilization of tracking applications via mobile phones, observation measures, a minimum 14-day quarantine measure, in accordance with relevant Thai laws and regulations concerning communicable diseases.</li></ul>	
<p>I agree to download the AOT Airports Application and submit the T.8 form via the Application prior to my arrival in Thailand. I hereby give my consent and accept that I shall be subject to State Quarantine for a period of 14 days from the date of my arrival into Thailand, at a facility or place of accommodation provided by the relevant authorities of Thailand. I also declare and accept that any and all expenses incurred from and/or in relation to the State Quarantine shall be my responsibility.</p>	

I certify that all the information declared above is true to my knowledge and give consent to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand to collect my personal information in order to coordinate with the concerned agencies for the purpose of screening and facilitating my travel to Thailand.

I declare that I have understood all that is stated above and shall strictly abide by them and comply with the provisions under the *Regulations issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) (No. 1), (No. 2), and (No. 3)*. I also declare and accept that I shall comply with any other disease prevention measures prescribed by the Government of Thailand, and acknowledge that failure of such compliance may lead to consequences under the laws and regulations of Thailand.
