Entry Measures into Thailand (effective from 1 July 2022 onwards)

As of 01 July 2022, Thailand Pass registration will be lifted for all incoming travellers and the medical issuance requirement will not be required for non-Thai travellers. However, upon arrival, fully vaccinated travellers must present vaccination certificates and non-fully vaccinated travellers must how PT-PCR/Professional ATK COVID-19 test results issued within 72 hours prior to departure.

Mixed Vaccination

Thailand fully recognizes mixed vaccination.

The second dose needs to be administered based on the recommended timeframe for each vaccine type (first dose)

- **REMARKS** To be considered fully vaccinated, your 2nd dose must be administered at least 14 days before your travel
 - Those vaccinated with the 1st dose of Janssen (Johnson&Johnson) or Sputnik Light vaccines are considered fully vaccinated

Vaccination Criteria for Travellers into Thailand

Aged below 5

- Can enter Thailand under the same scheme as their guardians if accompanied by their guardians



Aged 5 - 17

- Can travel alone if vaccinated with at least 1 dose of COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days before travel
 If unvaccinated but accompanied by guardians, can enter Thailand under the same scheme as their guardians

Aged 18 and over

- Must be fully vaccinated at least 14 days before travel



Remarks*

Persons who are vaccinated with at least 1 dose of COVID-19 vaccine after their recovery from COVID-19 infection (must have a medical certificate certifying their recovery) are considered fully vaccinated
