



MULTIPLE ENTRY TOURIST VISA (METV)

On 28 July 2015, the Royal Thai Government launched the METV scheme. This new scheme is an addition to the already existing sixty (60) days tourist visa with single entry, and will be effective from **Friday, 13 November 2015** onward.

The METV is available to tourists of all countries except for a list of 29 specific countries – please enquire with the Royal Thai Honorary Consulate-General if your country applies to this list.

Applicants may apply for the METV at all Thai Embassies, Consulates-General as well as Honorary Consulates-General/Consulate worldwide. The visa fee for METV is **PGK580**, with a visa validity of six (6) months, and the duration of stay of up to sixty (60) days per visit.

The documents required to apply for a METV are as follows:

- 1) A valid passport or travel document recognized by Thailand with validity of six (6) months or more.
- 2) Applicants must be a Papua New Guinean or permanent resident.
- 3) Evidence of adequate finance (no less than \$8,000 AUD or 200,000 Baht)
- 4) A verification letter issued and signed by the employer or universities.
- 5) Plane ticket paid in full for the first visit to Thailand and itinerary for the next visit.
- 6) A confirmed accommodation for the duration of stay in Thailand for the first visit.
