NOTICE ABOUT YOUR VISA

It is very important to understand that:

A visa does not guarantee entry into Thailand. It however simply indicates that your application has been reviewed by a consular officer and that he or she has determined you are eligible to enter the country for a specific purpose and permitted time. This visa allows you to travel to Thailand as far as the port of entry and ask the Immigration officer to allow you to enter the Kingdom. **ONLY THE IMMIGRATION OFFICER HAS THE AUTHORITY TO PERMIT YOU TO ENTER THAILAND AND TO DETERMINE THE DURATION OF YOUR STAY.**

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. The application form must be completed and submitted together with the following:
 1. Passport or travel document valid for at least 6 months from expected date of travel;
 2. One passport-sized photograph taken within the last 6 months;
 3. Valid ticket to Thailand or confirmed itinerary;
 4. Evidence of sufficient funds during period of stay in Thailand (at least PGK 2,000);
 5. Letter of invitation from host in Thailand (if business, education or conference.)
 6. Letter from employer stating objective of the visit to Thailand (if business, education or conference)

Consular officers reserve the right to request for additional document(s) as deemed necessary

2. Holders of valid passports of some countries, on transit through Thailand may spend up to 30 days in the country without a visa provided that they have confirmed travelling reservation out of Thailand within that period. Their passports and tickets must be shown to the Immigration Officer at the point of entry. *Enquire with the Consulate-General if this applies to you.*
 3. Type of visa issued:
 - a. Transit Visa - for transit purpose and flight connection only, a confirmed ticket out of Thailand is required.
 - b. Tourist Visa - for tourists, good for 60 days in Thailand
 - c. Non-Immigrant Visa - good for 90 days in Thailand. A supporting letter is required. For a stay of more than 90 days, prior approval from the Thai Immigration authorities in Bangkok, which may take up to 3 months, is needed.
 - d. Official/Diplomatic Visa - an official explanatory letter is required.
 4. A visa must be utilised within 3 months from the date issue. It is good for one entry only. However, two entries may be granted upon request and at the discretion of the Consulate-General.
 5. Visa Fees:
 - o Transit Visa – K80.00 for each entry
 - o Tourist Visa – K95.00 for each entry
 - o Non-Immigrant Visa – K190.00 for each entry.
 6. **Only cash or bank cheque will be accepted.** The Consulate-General is not able to accept Thai Baht, personal cheques or credit cards. Fees are payable in local Kina currency and are subject to change without notice. Visa fees are charged to cover the cost of processing an application. If an application is refused, the fee is not refundable.
 7. If the applicant wants his/her passport returned by post, a prepaid self-addressed express post envelope is required for each passport.
