VISA REQUIREMENTS & INFORMATION

Application forms must be completed and submitted together with the following documents:

1. PASSPORT

An original passport whether Diplomatic, Official or Standard valid for **more than six (6) months** from expected date of travel.

2. DIPLOMATIC AND OFFICIAL PASSPORTS

A Diplomatic Note from the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (for Papua New Guinea nationals) or Diplomatic Mission.

3. PHOTO

One passport-sized photograph (no scanned photos) taken within the last six (6) months.

4. PASSPORT PHOTOPAGE

One photocopy of the passport photo page and validity page (where appropriate).

5. ITINERARY

Valid ticket to Thailand or confirmed itinerary.

6. PURPOSE OF TRAVEL TO THAILAND:

6.1 Tourist – Letter from your employer stating that you are on holidays and will be returning to work.

6.2 Non-Immigrant – Official letter of invitation from host in Thailand to attend for business, education, conference AND a letter from your employer in Papua New Guinea stating objective of the visit to Thailand.

6.3 Transit – Copy of confirmed ticket showing onward journey to a third country.

7. EVIDENCE OF SUFFICIENT FUNDS DURING PERIOD OF STAY IN THAILAND:

7.1 Tourist – Copy of your personal bank statement from your bank.

7.2 Non-Immigrant – Copy of your approved daily allowance.

8. TYPE OF VISA ISSUED

Transit Visa – good for 30 days in Thailand. To travel in transit through the Kingdom or at the airport exceeding 12 hours to proceed to country of destination, proof of confirmed onward ticket to a Third country is required.

Tourist Visa - good for 60 days in Thailand (employment prohibited).

Non-Immigrant Visa - good for 90 days in Thailand. For a stay of more than 90 days, prior approval from the Thai Immigration authorities in Bangkok, which may take up to 3 months, is needed.

A visa must be utilised within 3 months from the date issue. It is good for one entry only. However, two entries may be granted upon request and at the discretion of the Consulate-General.

9. VISA FEES

Transit Visa – K80.00 for each entry.

Tourist Visa – K95.00 for single entry.

Non-Immigrant Visa – K190.00 for single entry only.

Only cash or bank cheque will be accepted. The Consulate-General is not able to accept Thai Baht, personal cheques or credit cards. Fees are payable in local Kina currency and are subject to change without notice. Visa fees are charged to cover the cost of processing an application, the fee is not refundable.

10. LENGTH OF VISA PROCESSING

9.1 All visas take a minimum of **three (3) working days** to process after the date of lodging the application.

9.2 All required documentation must be photocopied and attached to each and every application regardless of whether they are travelling as an individual, a group or family.

9.3 Visas applications will not be processed until the details on the visa application form are completed correctly and in full and ALL required documentation are submitted.

Consular officers reserve the right to request for additional document(s) as deemed necessary

11. VISA SECTION HOURS

08:00 – 12:00 hrs. Monday – Friday **Lodging application only.**

14:00 – 15:00 hrs. Monday – Friday **Collection of passport only.**

12. Holders of valid passports of some countries, on transit through Thailand may spend up to 30 days in the country without a visa provided that they have confirmed travelling reservation out of Thailand within that period. Their passports and tickets must be shown to the Immigration Officer at the point of entry. *Enquire with the Consulate-General if this applies to you.*

13. If the applicant wants his/her passport returned by post, a prepaid self-addressed express post envelope is required for each passport. No responsibility is taken for any loss or damage via post.

14. **NOTE:** We will NOT accept application form electronically. Please do NOT send your application via e-mail. Forms must be printed and brought with you together with other documents to the Royal Thai Consulate-General in Port Moresby. The Digital Signature does not comply with current Thai law, please DO NOT use digital signature. **Application form MUST be printed, signed and dated.**

NOTICE ABOUT YOUR VISA

It is very important to understand that:

A visa does not guarantee entry into Thailand. It however simply indicates that your application has been reviewed by a consular officer and that he or she has determined you are eligible to enter the country for a specific purpose and permitted time. This visa allows you to travel to Thailand as far as the port of entry and ask the Immigration officer to allow you to enter the Kingdom. **ONLY THE IMMIGRATION OFFICER HAS THE AUTHORITY TO PERMIT YOU TO ENTER THAILAND AND TO DETERMINE THE DURATION OF YOUR STAY.**
